KEYNOTE RIDER

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Note to the purchaser:

If for any reason any of the requests within this rider cannot be met, please let us know and we will find a workaround.

We look forward to working with you and we understand that every event is unique and presents its own challenges...and opportunities! We will all work together, have fun and never forget that it's about inspiring and motivating your guests.

Let's expect great things for this event and together keep asking:

“What else is possible?”

STAGE

It is recommended that the performance area is clear of obstruction such as podiums, band or DJ equipment. We understand at some corporate events this is not an option. If that is the case, please let us know asap so we can plan accordingly. If the audience exceeds 80 people, it is recommended that the stage area be elevated at least 1' high. If the audience exceeds 250 people, the elevation should be at least 2' feet high; 3' height if the audience exceeds 600. Devin will use audience participants and it is important they can get on and off the stage easily. Please have steps located in the front of the stage leading down into the audience or steps located on the side(s) of the stage that lead down into the audience.

SOUND SYSTEM

A great PA system is extremely important. It must be high quality and suitable for both speaking and music playback, and must consist of the following:

- Lavalier Mic
- One hand-held wireless microphone
- Batteries for lavalier mic and wireless mic

IMPORTANT: Most performance facilities have proper PA systems, however, Lecture Halls or Band Systems are often not suitable. In-house PA systems with speakers mounted in the ceiling usually do not suffice. If in doubt, please call to discuss at least one week prior to the day of the event. If these requirements are unavailable at the facility, other arrangements might need to be made with a PA system supplier or rental company.

VIDEO

Video is an essential part of the show!

Devin shows pictures, video clips and plays music throughout his presentation. For this, projector(s) and screen(s) should be set up on either side of the stage or as a large screen positioned Upstage Center. LED walls are awesome!

----- ***Video screen(s) must be clearly visible to ALL audience members*** -----

- **Preferred PowerPoint Clicker: DSAN PERFECT CUE.** Devin is self-sufficient with advancing his slides and playing his music and video. Devin will advance his own slides using the perfect cue remote. Therefore, the perfect cue must be plugged into his laptop. The laptop can be housed anywhere that is convenient for the production team.
- **Provide dongles / adapters:** The presentation is run through Microsoft PowerPoint from a 2020 Apple MacBook Pro laptop.

- **Laptop**
 - 4 x USB-C ports
 - Headphone / audio output



- **Audio:**

Music will come from Devin's laptop at random times during the presentation. Audio must be 'live' throughout the entire presentation. Devin will cue his own music using the perfect cue remote.

- **IMAGE MAGNIFICATION (IMAG): 2 (two) camera setup provided by purchaser**
 - **CAMERA #1** An HD (1080i) camera, with camera operator, positioned at the back of the venue center, on a tripod, with a lens capable of shooting full body, as well as tight and crisp close-up shots. The ability to zoom in close on items in Devin's hands (such as a playing card or dollar bill) is important. Please refer to the photo below for the zoom that will be required from the camera located in the back of the venue.

It is important that this camera can zoom in and clearly show that the 2 mixed Rubik's Cube match.



- **CAMERA #2** An HD (1080i). **A camera operator is NOT necessary.** This camera can be robotic or a camera attached to a truss. It does not need to be a large camera. It can be a smaller camera on a stand or tripod (as seen in picture below). CAMERA #2 lens must get a tight and crisp close-up shot of the top of the table and details, such as the value of playing cards, and must be clear to the entire audience when they are displayed.

This camera shot will be tested during the tech check and will be LOCKED in position. Its only purpose will be to shoot the top of the table where Devin will be performing magic. PLEASE DO NOT attempt to use this camera during the performance to get a creative “cutaway” shot. This camera will remain stationary the entire time.

—— If possible, provide a mounted hot shoe LED camera light - this eliminates shadows ——

CAMERA #2 in position on stage seen in the picture below.



It is important that Camera #2 gets a tight crisp close-up shot of the cards (as seen below).
This is the only shot that this camera will take throughout the entire performance.



PICTURE IN PICTURE OPTION

Combining Camera 1 and Camera 2 into the screen simultaneously is awesome, as seen in the picture below.



Camera 2 (Playing Cards) will be larger while Camera 1 (Front of house) will show me smaller.

- **Confidence Monitor(s):**
 - If 1(one) monitor is used - Displaying, at all times, what the audience is seeing on the house screen(s). Whether it is content from laptop or IMAG
 - If (2)two monitors are used - 2(two) connections to the laptop. Independent feeds. One for each connection to the laptop.
 - Monitor #1 - In 'presenter view' displaying the KEYNOTE presentation from laptop
 - Monitor #2 - Displaying, at all times, what the audience is seeing on the house screen(s). Whether it is content from laptop or IMAG
- Must be able to seamlessly switch between pictures/videos on the MacBook laptop and the IMAG throughout the entire show. During the tech check, Devin will instruct the production team on when to transition between different cameras and PowerPoint slides. He may also give occasional instructions once the keynote begins by speaking directly to them.

If it would be possible to record Devin's presentation on both cameras and supply him with a copy for marketing purposes, it would be greatly appreciated!

Devin will have a SAMSUNG T7 Shield 2TB hard drive at the event to store the footage.

PROPS Purchaser shall provide items listed below:

1 (one) - Beach ball between 16 - 24 inches. Devin will toss this into the crowd to choose a random volunteer. Another soft object that has a little weight (for throwing) will also work, such as a stress ball or rolled up T-shirt.



1 (one) - One Roll of Black Gaff Tape



1 (one) - A standard tripod with a fixed screw connection (for Devin's camcorder)



STAGE ITEMS Purchaser shall provide items listed below:

1 (one) - 6ft rectangular table (4ft table will work) + linen covering that touches the floor on at least the two sides and front. Black linen is preferred. Devin will be sitting at the table and will need to be able to access underneath from the back. A spandex table cloth will not work as Devin's needs to be seated with his legs under the table.



4 (four) - Extra Linen Tablecloths. Must be a solid color with no patterns (black is preferred).



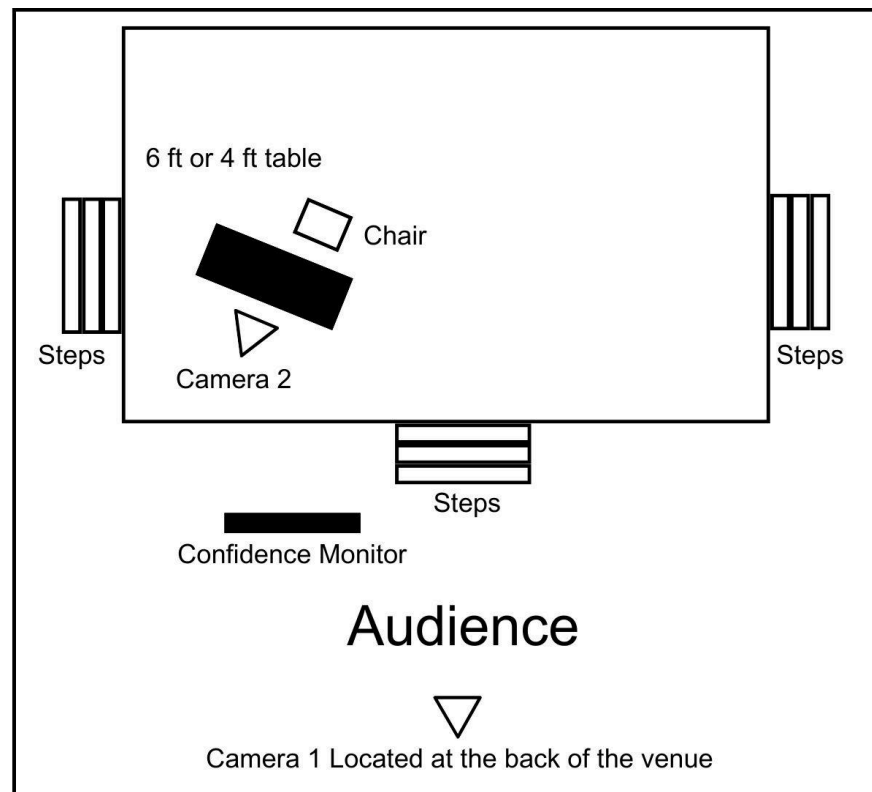
1 (one) - Chair. Not a barstool – just a normal chair with no arms.



STAGE PLOT

Setup may change during rehearsal - TBD - **DEVIN IS FLEXIBLE**

- We understand that due to stage constraints this setup might not be possible. Contact us ASAP to discuss and we will resolve to make the best of the situation.
- Devin is flexible with regards to the location of the DSM / Confidence Monitor(s). TBD
- Steps located either on the sides or in the front. Either is acceptable.
- If a Podium is on stage, If possible, please strike the Podium before Devin's presentation. It only blocks people's view.



The table can be located stage right, stage left or center stage depending on stage / camera locations / Screen locations, etc - TBD

GREEN ROOM

(If Green room is available)

- 3 (three) Bottled Waters - room temperature
- 2 (two) bananas
- 1 (one) lime-flavored sparkling water (eg: LaCroix, Bubbly brands) - cold
- M&Ms - green only. Just kidding LOL! No M&Ms.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Non-smoking hotel room. The night before the show and the night of the show. If Consecutive presentation dates occur, rooms will be provided for the length of the run.

1 suite- King Bed
